Admission Requirements

- Have a bachelor's degree from an accredited University, preferably in Theology/Religion or any other Non-Theology/Religion degree with a minimum CGPA of 3.00 on a 4-point scale or its equivalent. Applicants with a CGPA of 2.5 to 2.99 on a 4-point scale or its equivalent may be accepted on probation. [Non-Theology/Religion bachelor's is acceptable, but will be required to complete an additional 30 credits]
- Provide two recommendations completed online: One from the local Church Board and one from your previous University or from the employing organisation if employed. The applicant should seek the consent of the referee before submitting their details.
- Must demonstrate proficiency in English.
